Lakeshore Foundation's "Operation Alpha"



WILSONVILLE, Alabama — Eleven military who have suffered traumatic brain injury in combat or on active duty spent this morning water skiing, sitskiing and tubing on Lay Lake near Wilsonville.

They and invited guests are two days at the Lakeshore Foundation's Operation Alpha, a weekend camp to help give injured military the tools they need to regain active and independent lives through fitness, recreation and sport. Friday's activities included rock climbing, scuba diving, archery, cycling, tennis and target shooting.

"Coming out here gives you a different look on life," said Staff Sgt.Dan Hill, who serves in the warrior transition program at Fort Benning, GA., and was injured by an explosion in Iraq in 2007. "You do things you never thought you could."

Hill says he still deals with problems in short-term memory as a result of his brain injury.

The Lakeshore Foundation held another Operation Alpha event for 11 veterans with traumatic brain injuries at the Adaptive Aquatics Center on Lay Lake near Wilsonville Alabama Saturday August 6, 2011. The veterans were able to seat ski, kayak, go fishing and take tube rides in and around Lay Lake. (The Birmingham News/Joe Songer)

Operation Alpha is one piece of Lakeshore's overarching Lima Foxtrot program for injured military. Other camps under the Lima Foxtrot banner include ones for military with blindness or vision loss (Operation Night Vision), and ones for military and their families.


